YEAR LEVELS: Years 7–12

PURPOSE: To encourage students and the college community to become more environmentally aware. The Green Team aims to create a positive change to Brentwood's environmental impact and improve the efficiency of the school facilities for the new millennium.

POSITION DESCRIPTION: The Green Team is a growing student action group within the Brentwood community. The group was founded after student's recognised the need for Brentwood to begin to become increasingly environmentally conscious, and improve the efficiency of the school facilities for the new millennium.

The Green Team focuses on:

1. Raising awareness within the school and wider community on how the environment is being adversely affected, and what we can do to combat this, rather than fundraising.
2. Creating collective passion for the environment around the school and wider community.
3. Being proactive and taking action.
