

## SRC VICE PRESIDENT

## APPLICABLE YEAR LEVELS:

## **POSITION DESCRIPTION:**

All year levels (Recommended Senior School)

The SRC Vice President is the support of the President in the Student Representative Council. It is suggested that there be a single Vice President; this can vary depending on the size and discretion of the SRC. They are responsible for the following:

- 1. To facilitate and chair meetings when the President is unable.
- 2. To work closely with the SRC President, and help create projects and initiatives for implementation.
- 3. To ensure that the members of the SRC are committed and to help with any issues that may arise internally.
- 4. To assist in delegation and help the running of the various events put in place by the SRC.
- 5. To be a Role Model for the school community.
- 6. To lead and encourage student leadership, particularly within the school community.
- 7. To mentor SRC members and help develop their leadership skills.
- 8. To encourage and promote interaction between SRC, Green Team and Vision Generation.

**TIME COMMITMENT:** The role of SRC Vice President can be time demanding. The Vice President should be able to find time outside of school time to assist with events that they may be involved in running with the SRC. It is recommended that the SRC Vice President isn't involved in any more than one other leadership position within the school community.

## **SKILLS REQUIRED:**

- 1. Demonstrated previous leadership skills.
- 2. Demonstrated communication skills including an ability to speak individually and in group/public forums.
- 3. Willingness to lead by example by upholding the values and rules of the school.
- 4. Organisational skills.
- 5. Ability to relate to a wide range of students and staff.
- 6. Demonstrated ability to show vision and how to implement this vision.
