

SPORT CAPTAIN

YEAR LEVELS: Year 8 to 12.

Two students from each year level (one male and one female).

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The Sport Captain represents the needs of the student body within the school and work with the Sport Coordinator to help organise, manage and conduct sporting events for the Brentwood community.

Expectations:

1. To uphold the school rules by being a role model and through the encouragement of other students particularly regarding punctuality, uniform, and positive behaviour.
2. To assist the Sport Coordinator with interschool competitions (athletics, swimming, fun run).
3. To manage events; ensure younger students know where to go; help organise equipment and uniform.
4. To promote sport at Brentwood.
5. To speak at all year level assemblies and present awards and certificates at assemblies.
6. Manage/coach Friday sporting activities in Term 2+3.

TIME COMMITMENT:

Ongoing at school sporting events and any other activities that the Sport Captains run in terms of planning, organisation and execution.

SKILLS REQUIRED:

1. To demonstrate excellent sportsmanship at all times
2. To be able to speak at assemblies/group events
3. Organisational ability
4. To demonstrate commitment, involvement and individual achievement in sport
5. To be considerate and deal with conflict effectively
6. To show initiative
7. To be able to communicate with a wide range of age groups, students, parents and staff
