YEAR LEVELS: Years 7 - 12

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Year Level Captains consist of one male and one female student from each Year Level. Their role is to build a sense of community within their Year Level and to consult with Student Managers regarding student issues that may arise within their year level.

Expectations:

- 1. To uphold the school rules by being a role model and through the encouragement of other students particularly regarding punctuality, uniform, and positive behaviour.
- 2. To listen to ideas and suggestions of students in the Year Level.
- 3. To organise, manage and conduct year level functions, events and camps.
- 4. To lead and encourage fellow students in the areas of student leadership and co-curricular activities.
- 5. To actively participate in the Brentwood Student Executive.
- 6. To attend leadership training.
- 7. To assist the Student Managers in running year level assemblies and to work closely with Student Managers to ensure important information is passed on to the year level.
- 8. To undertake any tasks for the year level as requested by the Student Managers.
- 9. To work with the Year 12 Ambassadors to promote and organise a team of students to assist/represent year level and whole school events.

TIME COMMITMENT:

Meetings as required, and use of lunchtimes to plan, organise and execute plans

SKILLS REQUIRED:

- 1. To be passionate about making a positive contribution to the school and wider community
- 2. To have the support of students in the Year Level
- 3. To be able to work individually and in a team
- 4. To be able to speak at assemblies/group events
- 5. To be able to relate to a wide range of age groups, students, parents and staff

- 7. To demonstrate a good academic record
